

TERMS OF USE OF WEBSITE

1. INTRODUCTION

This policy sets out the terms you agree to abide by when accessing or visiting our website www.ifaroma.org (herein referred to as 'our site').

2. PURPOSE

Our website is maintained for therapists, qualification providers, employers, educators, the press and the public.

3. GENERAL TERMS OF USE

By visiting or using our site in any capacity, you indicate that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to abide by them. If you do not agree to these terms of use, please refrain from using our site.

You also agree:

b) Not to reproduce, duplicate, copy or re-sell any part of our site in contravention of the provisions of our terms of website use and copyright (see point 7 for more details).

- a) To transmit, or procure the sending of, any unsolicited or unauthorised advertising or promotional material or any other form of similar solicitation (spam).

4. ACCESSING OUR SITE

If you are a business, these terms of use, its subject matter and its formation (and any non-contractual disputes or claims) are governed by English law. We both agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
